Minutes of Meetings

Minutes of Joint IASO EC and IJSO Editorial Board Hybrid Meeting held on 6.10.2022 at NATCON Madurai

Present: From IASO-Hony President Dr Rajendra Toprani, Hony President Elect Dr Prafulla Kumar Das, Vice President Dr S V S Deo, Immediate Past President Dr Arnab Gupta, Dr Chandrakant Are, Secretary Dr Somashekhar, Editorial Secretary Dr Shaikat Gupta, and all zonal EC members.

Past Presidents: Dr B K C Mohan Prasad, Dr Kiran Kothari, Dr Harit Chaturvedi, Dr Arun Chaturvedi, Dr Sanjay Sharma, Dr Sanjeev Mishra.

From IJSO: Chief Editor Dr K S Gopinath and entire IJSO Editorial Board.

Meeting began with Welcome address by Dr Toprani and Dr Gopinath, and a minute's silence was observed in memory of Late Dr Devendra Patel. A tribute was paid to Late Prof L H Blumgart and it was decided to dedicate an HPB issue of IJSO to him.

1. Minutes of virtual meeting held on 24.10.2021 were reviewed and passed.
2. Ms Deepshikha from Springer India gave a detailed presentation on Journal Metrics, Editorial development, production volume, production turnaround time, ORCID, circulation and Usage. Regarding journal impact, the Cite score rank is 0.9. Mr Deepshikha stressed that IJSO is in bottom quartile compared to peers and needs to improve performance. EC decided not to give Reviewer remunerations and to start a Twitter handle.
3. Annual Report by Dr M Vijaykumar, presented by Dr Rohan Shetty – Problems plaguing the journal like abnormal delays and rejections were discussed, as also problems faced by Associate Editor. It was found that main delays and work flow issues were happening at Sectional Editor and Reviewer level.
4. **Treasurer Report by Dr Somashekhar(IJSO account)-** Treasurer declared that there is no separate account for journal, and that IASO account and Treasurer deals with all IJSO finances. He submitted that although the total income from journal exceeds INR 1.1 Cr, the net income from journal is only INR 1581826, as most of income goes in paying Springer.
5. **IJSO Byelaws and rectifications, by Chief Editor Dr K S Gopinath-** IASO EC and IJSO Editorial Board unanimously agreed that several changes are required for IJSO bylaws to overcome the short comings and give an opportunity for more IASO members to get involved in IJSO. All issues were taken into account and the opinion of senior leadership and Past Presidents were noted. IJSO is an integral part of IASO. The relevant issues were to define eligibility criteria of each position at IJSO Editorial Board & revamp Editorial Council. To form a consensus, President proposed and EC passed the following resolution to form a Committee comprising President, Secretary and last 5 Past Presidents (seven member committee). The Chief Editor has proposed changes from IJSO side. This Committee will deliberate on all the above and give their proposal to EC which will be discussed at Agra MIDCON and subsequently placed at GBM. Till then, the existing IJSO Editorial Board is requested to carry on caretaker functions. All applications / nominations received for all positions this year will be valid for consideration once fresh nominations are announced after the bylaws are amended by GBM. This resolution was uniformly ratified and passed by IASO EC and IJSO Editorial Board.

Minutes of IASO EC Meeting held on 6.10.2022 at NATCON Madurai

Meeting was called to order by Dr Toprani and a minute's silence was observed in memory of Late Dr Dhairyasheel Sawant.

- Minutes of previous meetings were discussed and passed by EC. It was decided henceforward to mail the previous minutes to EC members 7 days before NATCON and MIDCON.
- Hony Secretary presented his report on successful activation and performance of IASO website and EC lauded the website taskforce, led by Dr Geeta. EC reviewed and complimented the academic team, led by Dr Subramanyeshwar Rao, on the commendable performance of IASO Masterclasses. EC reviewed and complimented Dr Goud and Dr Sanjay Sen on successful PG outreach programmes and training classes. Dr Caleb Harris presented his report on MIDCON Shillong, and was appreciated by all.
- Hony Secretary presented the list of future meetings, including in Jodhpur in December, Lataguri in January and MIDCON Agra from 10-12 March 2023.
- Zonal redistribution – Considering the imbalance in membership numbers between different zones, EC proposed a system whereby there will be one zonal member per 250 members. This will be a dynamic system to be re evaluated every five years, as membership numbers change. EC decided to place this proposal before GBM for ratification.
- Dr Caleb Harris proposed setting up of state level surgical oncology societies under the aegis of IASO. EC decided that this was not possible as of now, but may be considered in future.
- EC discussed the establishment of post MCh/ DNB organ based Fellowships, under the aegis of IASO, to be considered as a long term plan for implementation. President Elect Dr P K Das proposed 6 month to one year IASO Travelling Fellowship Award, to be granted to deserving candidates selected by a committee set up within EC.
- Dr Sanjay Desai gave his report on Indore Zonal Meeting and will declare his contribution to IASO during the GBM.
- Dr H Ramesh was declared the winner in IASO online elections for the post of EC member South.
- Treasurer Report (details separately) - Hony Treasurer Dr Somashekhar gave detailed presentation on IASO accounts. Income and expenditure list was presented. All figures are as of date and in INR. Total fixed deposit amount- 25042818.00. Interest on FD- 1586421.00. Current account- 1705126.82. Income from 210 new members- 1700000.00. Amount received from MIDCON Shillong-700000.00. Settlement of pending IT dues- 1730330.00. Income from journal-1581826.00. Total expenditure- 4869765.00. Hence net profit as of date last FY- 872941.81(excluding 12 lakhs to be received from NATCON Delhi OC). Total holding amount as of date approximately INR 2.7Cr.

Minutes of General Body Meeting held on 8.10.2022 at NATCON Madurai

Present: Hony president Dr Rajendra Toprani, President Elect Dr P K Das, Immediate Past president Dr Arnab Gupta, Secretary Dr Chandramohan, Treasurer Dr Somashekhar, Editorial Secretary Dr Shaikat Gupta, All zonal EC members, Past Presidents and General body.

Hony President Dr Toprani called meeting to order and gave his welcome address. He announced the revival of the Detroit Fellowship and lauded by GBM.

Secretary went through the agenda and following discussions as below

- Minutes of previous EC Meetings of Nov 2021, Feb 2022, March 2022, May 2022 and July 2022, which were circulated earlier by Dec 2021, April 2022 and July 2022 Newsletter were passed.
- The minutes of past GB Meeting dated 30/10/2021 which were circulated in the December 2021 newsletter was also discussed and passed.
- The EC decision dated 6/10/2022 on opening of post MCh/DNB organ based Fellowship awards to young surgeons inside India was passed by GBM. The details on how to implement will be discussed in the next EC Meeting.
- IASO logo as designed and instituted at NATCON Delhi was reviewed and passed.
- GBM discussed and passed the replacement of Radha Devi oration with Dr Ashok Mehta Oration, and lauded the contribution of INR 20 lakhs plus by Dr Ashok Mehta for the institution of a lifetime oration in his name. Pursuant to this GBM reviewed and passed the institution of time bound orations in the name of doyens of Surgical Oncology only, to the tune of 10 lakhs for 5 years and 20 lakhs for 10 years. Anything exceeding this amount can be taken as a lifetime oration contribution, by prerogative of President.
- **Reconstitution of IJSO Editorial Board-** GBM unanimously agreed that several changes are required for IJSO bylaws to overcome the short comings and give an opportunity for more IASO members to get involved in IJSO. All issues were taken into account and the opinion of senior leadership and Past Presidents were noted. IJSO is an integral part of IASO. - There was a discussion on whether IJSO should be online or hardcopy. There were differences of opinion and GBM decided to take into consideration individual members choices and discuss in next GBM. - **Zone wise EC seats** –The problem of inadequate number of seats from South Zone compared to number of aspirants was discussed and deliberated at length, and there were great differences of opinion amongst members. GBM could not come to a conclusion and decided to appoint a 3 member committee of Immediate Past Presidents, to examine the matter and propose solutions at MIDCON, Agra. Amount received from MIDCON Shillong-700000.00. Amount received from NATCON 2021 Delhi- 12,20,000.00.Settlement of pending IT dues- 1730330.00. 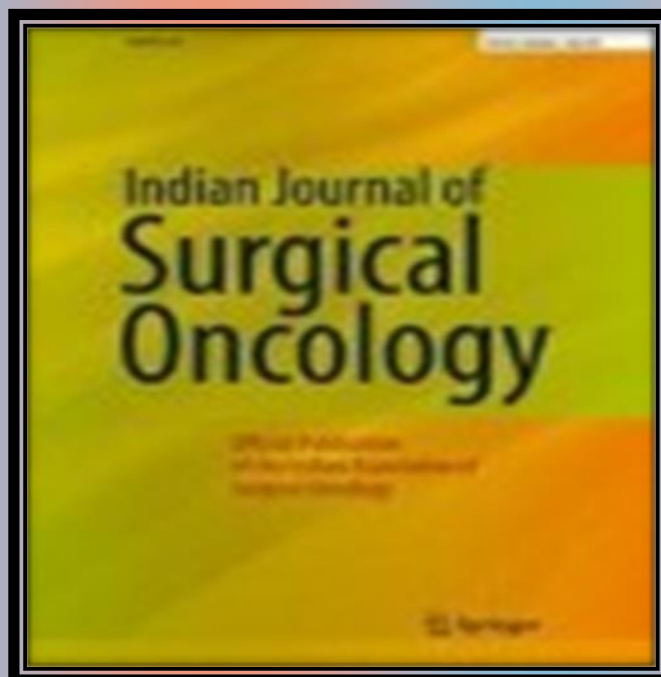

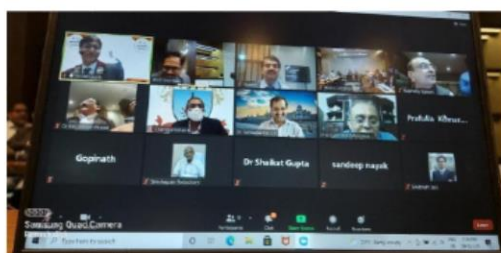
REPORT ON IASO NATCON 2022 AT MADURAI

The conduct of the 35th Annual National Conference of Indian Association of Surgical Oncology (IASO NATCON 2022) was handed over to the Department of Surgical Oncology, Government Rajaji Hospital & Madurai Medical College, Madurai in Association with TASO (Tamil Nadu Association of Surgical Oncologist) on 30th October 2021 at IASO NATCON 2021 conference, Delhi, by the National Body of IASO.

IASO NATCON 2022, held in Madurai, Tamil Nadu, India from 6th to 9th of October 2022 was the first post covid - physical National conference of IASO. This is also the first of its kind to be held at the temple city Madurai.

The charge of IASO NATCON 2022 was given to **Dr. M. Ramesh** as Organizing Secretary of NATCON 2022 (Head of Department of Surgical Oncology, Madurai Medical College & Govt Rajaji Hospital), under the guidance of Organizing Chairman Dr. B.K.C Mohan Prasad, along with Senior Surgical Oncologists of Tamil Nadu as advisors and patrons. Fourteen (14) of the Surgical Oncologist of Madurai formed the core organizing committee for the conduct of this mega event. Various committee were formed from the members of TASO, (Patrons/ Core Committee/ Advisory Committee/ Scientific Committee/ Trade/ PG Trainee coordination/ Accommodation/ Tour committee).

The preparation for the conference had begun as early from the December 2021, when Event organizers and Audio-Visual team were fixed. Venue for the Conference was finalized in Hotel Courtyard by Marriott, Madurai, where 4 Halls, Board Room, lawn, parking space for stalls were booked.



Gross outline of the scientific program and rest of the conference was drafted and presented during the MIDCON conference 25th - 27th March 2022 in Shillong to the National committee. Subsequently the first Brochure was released in February 2022 and online registration also started during same month.



The promotion for the NATCON 2022 started way back in MIDCON - March 2022 followed by KASOCON -May 2022, ABSCICON August 2022, West ZONE CME IASO/AROI INDORE 2022, ASI Tamil Nadu by the organizing Secretary and other organizing committee members, briefing about the conference in these events.



The Promotion for conference was also done with frequent videos, presentations, and fliers, through social media (whatsapp/telegram/facebook) and through conference portal and IASO portal (secretariat@natconiaso2022.com).

The database of members was retrieved from the IASO office and all the members were reached through official mail communications, messages and subsequently we reached almost all through phone calls. Fliers and Posters were sent to all teaching institutions of surgical oncology (DrNB & MCh) across India. All HOD's of the surgical oncology teaching institutes all over India were directly communicated on call to promote registrations of faculties and residents. Also, postgraduates in Gynecology, General surgery, ENT, orthopedics in various medical colleges of Tamil Nadu, likely to take up Oncology in future, were encouraged with single day registrations.



Scientific committee for NATCON 2022 was formed by President IASO which met almost 10 times through virtual platform and physical meetings twice at Indore and Madurai. There were frequent visits and meeting at venue with hotel officials, AV team and Event team to finalize the course of conference. President IASO, Secretary IASO visited the Venue for Inspection on 11th June 2022 to supervise the arrangements of conference.



In month of July 2022 the NATCON faculties were decided for the scientific program via online/zoom meetings and with physical meetings at Indore conference (AROI/IASO 2022). The chosen faculties were contacted through phone and mail communication. Along with National faculties, 9 international faculties from USA, Brazil, UK, Sweden were invited, of which 6 faculties visited the conference physically, whereas 3 foreign faculties and one national faculty (Dr. Shailesh Shrikhande) who couldn't attend the conference, were made themselves available through online platform. The IASO NATCON 2022 also gave opportunity to many younger faculties to showcase their work in such a grand event. Overall, 245 faculties participated in the conference across the country.





The NATCON 2022 programme consisted of 4 days schedule with workshop held on 6th October and main conference events from 7th-9th October 2022. The Pre-conference workshop demonstrated 32 operative videos by eminent faculties followed by 3 lectures for residents on related specialties like Onco-pathology, Interventional Radiology and Radiology. Hands on Training was organized for residents on bowel Stapling and Microvascular anastomosis which had enormous participation and phenomenal appreciations.





The main conference event covered the important and recent advances of all the subspecialties of surgical oncology and consisted of 29 master videos (operative technique video demonstrated by experts), 22 group discussions (Panel discussion, Symposium), 33 keynote lectures, 6 Debates, 5 Orations. There was one formal Meet the Professor sessions for budding Surgical Oncologist to discuss their future perspective which was conducted by Dr. Chandrakant Are (USA) through Zoom Meeting. Besides, many young delegates took the opportunity to interact with the foreign faculties and senior faculties in the interval times for their career prospects.





On the last date of the abstract submission we had flooding of the abstracts submission (504) which Organizing Committee found difficult to sort it out. Dr. P.K. Das (President Elect IASO) and Dr. Chandramohan K (secretary IASO) came to Madurai to sort it out with the help of rest of the scientific committee member through online. Finally 428 were permitted for presentation including the IASO awards.





Inaugural Function was held on 7th October with Dr. Ashok Mehta (Founder Secretary IASO & Past president IASO) as Chief Guest, Dr. Anil D’Cruz (President UICC) as Guest of Honour, along with Dr. A. Rathinavel (Dean Madurai Medical College) and the function started in the traditional way of lighting the lamps.

First time our own legends were invited as Guest for the Inaugural function. Similarly, all the past presidents present during the conference were honoured by the IASO President for the first time. All the Foreign Faculties were also honoured on the occasion. NATCON Souvenir was also released during the Inaugural function.







Executive committee meeting and IJSO meeting were conducted on pre-conference day. The General body meeting was conducted on 8th October and various issues were discussed. On 9th October the New EC committee had meeting to discuss the forthcoming issues of IASO.



IASO NATCON 2022 had 935 registrations (including National and foreign faculty, delegates, Medical and Radiation Oncologist, Nuclear medicine physicist and post graduate students of Urology, Gynecology, ENT, Orthopedics, surgical gastroenterology), highest number in the history of NATCON. Single day registration was promoted to encourage post graduate student participation of other surgical specialties. Delegates were from Kashmir to Kanyakumari and from Jodhpur to Shillong.





On all 4 days lunch were served at Venue and Dinner was provided for 3 days. Banquet was arranged at Hotel Fortune Pandiyan on 8th October for all delegates which had many dance and singing shows by professionals, fireworks and DJ followed by Grand gala dinner.





Except the Foreign faculties and guest faculties for whom registration was provided complimentary, other faculties and delegates made their registration and transport arrangements by themselves, which shows the keenness of our IASO members in making it to the NATCON.

During the conference there were only 4 last moment dropouts in faculty position, for which replacements were timely arranged so as to avoid any pause in flow of conference scientific agenda. This figure is very insignificant and shows the commitment of the faculties to the IASO. Another best thing observed during conference was that all the faculties adhered to the timings which made the job of Organizing committee easy. Adherence to timings and seamless event was well appreciated by everyone and largely due to the meticulous planning by the organizing committee and cooperation by the faculties.

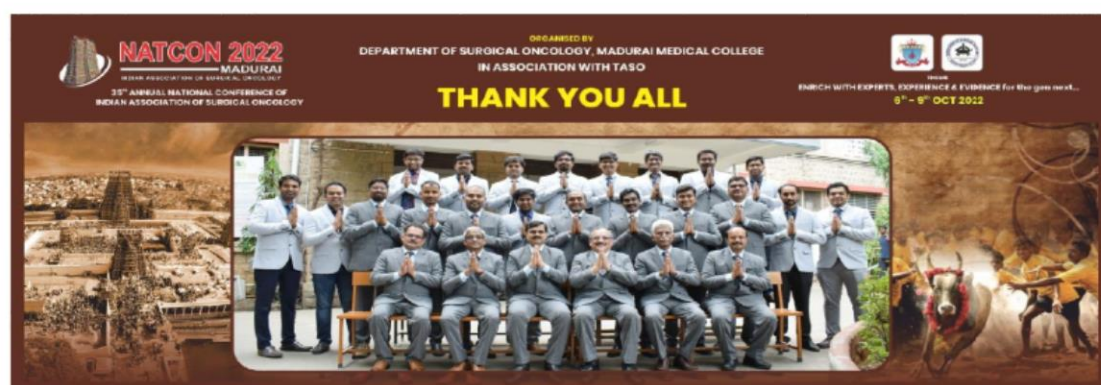
Air-conditioned exhibition areas were provided for all the Surgical/Pharmaceuticals company for display of their products during the event.

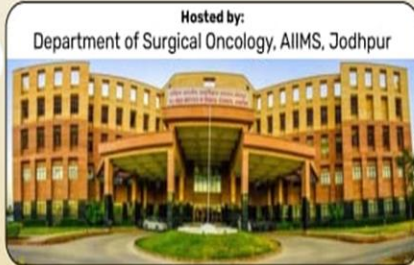
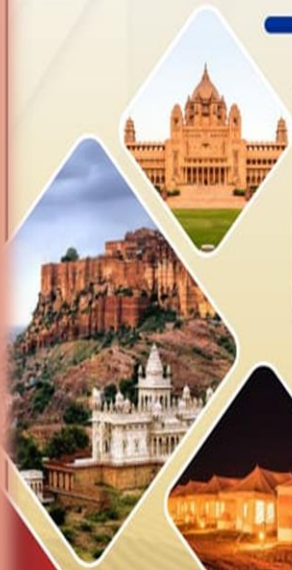

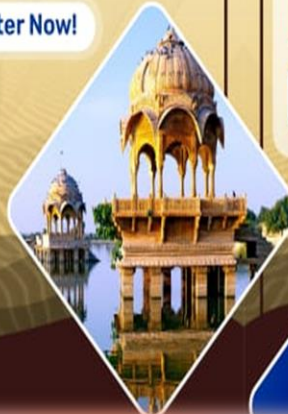

The score is a weighted count of the different sources (newspaper stories, tweets, blog posts, comments) that mention the paper.
