## **Minutes of Meetings**

---

### **MINUTES OF IASO EC MEETING AT JODHPUR ZONAL MEETING 9.12.2022**

**PRESENT:** Honble President Dr P K Das, Immediate Past President Dr Rajendra Toprani, President Elect Dr S V S Deo, Honble Secretary Dr Chandramohan, Editorial Secretary Dr Shaikat Gupta, Web secretary Dr Ashutosh Mishra, Zonal EC members Dr Devendra Chaukar, Dr Pankaj Garg, Dr Sanjay Sen, Dr Devendra Parikh, Dr Manisa Patnaik, Dr Sandeep Agarwal, Dr Ramesh.

The meeting began at 6PM with welcome address by President, who brought the meeting to order.

Secretary outlined the agenda for the meeting.

**1. Update on zonal seat redistribution:**

The 5 member committee comprising President, Secretary and three immediate Past Presidents had a meeting on 8.11.2022. As per the decision taken at the meeting, an online polling was done, to which 100 IASO members responded. Secretary declared the result of the poll, which is as follows. In response to the first proposal to include Telengana and Andhra Pradesh in Eastern zone, 80% voted against. In response to the second proposal to have zonal representation in EC proportionate to the number of members in each zone, 80% voted in favour of the proposal. EC decided that in view of the less number of responses to the online poll, the same should be recirculated once again amongst all IASO members, a month's time given and a final decision on the issue to be taken at next EC meeting at Lataguri Eastern Zonal Conference.

**2. IASO Travelling Fellowship**

EC discussed the issue at length, based on the findings and observations of the 9 member committee led by Chairman Academic Council Dr T Subramanyeshwar Rao. The other members of the Committee being President Dr P K Das, Secretary Dr Chandramohan, Immediate Past President Dr Rajendra Toprani, Past President Dr Harit Chaturvedi, Vice President Dr Sharad Desai, President Elect Dr S V S Deo, Treasurer Dr Somashekhar and Editorial Secretary Dr Shaikat Gupta.

EC decided to concentrate for the time being on starting the short term IASO Fellowships at reputed Institutes. To that end, EC decided to have a separate meeting of the 9 member committee on 4.1.2023, to take final decisions on eligibility, duration and centers, to be presented to EC in Zonal Meeting in Lataguri.

**3. Update on MIDCON and NATCON**

**EC decided to create a uniform conference format to be followed in all future NATCONs and MIDCONs, to be called The Blue Book. The responsibility to design and create this was given to Dr Ashutosh Mishra and Dr Ramesh under the leadership of Secretary Dr Chandramohan. This committee will present the finished template to EC in MIDCON 2023 in Agra.**

**4. Update on MoU for ICC 2023 and NATCON 2024.**

**EC approved the decision to draft a MoU between IASO and ICC 2023 organisers, to be executed by the official IASO accountant. The purpose of the MoU is to avoid double taxation. Treasurer to give an update on MoU in MIDCON Agra.**

**5. Update on SSO (USA) Meeting**

**EC decided to continue its close partnership with SSO, and to spend more money and effort to increase international exposure of young surgeons. To that end, EC urged all its members to try and increase international partnerships, using personal contacts.**

**Of the 17 IASO awardee candidates selected to attend SSO, only 3 have valid US visa. Dr Toprani, Dr P K Das and Dr Chandramohan would try to expedite the visa process for the awardees, with the help of SSO leadership. The possibility of a direct communication from SSO leadership to the US consulate was also discussed.**

**EC affirmed that Detroit Fellowship and ESSO Fellowship in on, and that the candidates have already been selected.**

**EC decided to continue the tradition of President and Secretary attending and representing IASO at annual SSO meetings.**

**6. Website**

**EC asked Web Secretary Dr Ashutosh Mishra to add a link on IASO website to upcoming international conferences.**

**7. IASO Eastern Zonal Conference at Lataguri**

**Dr Sanjay Sen gave a presentation on the upcoming Eastern zonal meeting to be held in Lataguri, West Bengal on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of January 2023. This one and a half day meeting, on the theme of ‘Frontiers in organ preservation’, will be hosted by the Oncology Society of Bengal, under the aegis of IASO. EC discussed the logistics, scientific agenda and other issues regarding the meeting. EC meeting to be held on 20.1.2023.**

**8. MIDCON 2023**

**Dr Sandeep Agarwal, Organising Secretary of MIDCON 2023 to be held at Agra, gave a presentation on the same, regarding dates, venue and scientific agenda. MIDCON 2023 will be held from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> March 2023, with the operative workshop on the last day of 12.3.2023.**

**9. ICC 2023**

**Dr Devendra Chaukar, Organising Secretary of ICC 2023, gave a detailed presentation on the same. EC decided to have the IASO-IJSO Joint EC Meeting, followed by the IASO EC Meeting, between 5 to 8PM on 1.11.2023. The IASO GBM will be held on 2.11.2023, and the meeting of new EC on Sunday 5.11. 2023. The orations will be delivered on 3.11.2023. The N C Mishra oration will be delivered by Dr M Gnant from Vienna. The four other orations will be delivered by SSO President, IASO Past President, Prof Akiyama and Prof Geoffrey Myers. It was decided that the IASO Program will be held in the afternoon and evening sessions, and the President and Secretary will coordinate with ICC OC regarding scientific programme. ICC OC declared its intention to give every participating organization a budget for orations, and the same was approved by EC.**

**10. Matters related to BSSO ( Brazil Society of Surgical Oncology)**

**EC decided that in the spirit of last NATCON at Madurai which saw participation from BSSO, IASO should also participate in BSSO meetings. Interested senior EC members should express their intention to IASO. They should bear travelling expenses, whilst BSSO will bear the cost of accommodation and registration.**

**11. Any other matter**

**Dr Pankaj Garg brought up the issue of IASO membership eligibility. EC discussed the issue at length, including all the ramifications. EC decided to take up the issue further in future.**

**The EC Meeting ended with Vote of Thanks by Secretary.**



## **Conference Report Zonal Meeting Jodhpur 2022**

The IASO Zonal Conference- Jodhpur 2022 was held at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur, from 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> December 2022. This is the first time, after the COVID pandemic, that an oncology conference of such a magnitude was being organized in this region of the country. The conference was organized by the Department of Surgical Oncology, AIIMS Jodhpur, in association with Suncity Surgeons' Society under the leadership of IASO torchbearers Dr. PK Das, President IASO, Dr. SVS Deo, President-Elect IASO, Dr. Rajendra Toprani, Immediate Past President, Dr. Chandramohan K, Secretary IASO, and other Executive Committee members.

Despite a very short preparatory time of 60 days, the conference received a very enthusiastic response from not only Rajasthan and adjoining states but also from all over the country, with over 400 registrations and 150 abstracts.



The theme of the conference was "Cancer Care: Engage-Empower-Evolve," wherein a pre-conference live surgery workshop was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> Dec, followed by a scientific extravaganza on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Dec 2022. The workshop featured live demonstrations of surgeries like breast conservation surgery, thyroidectomy, Robotic Low Anterior Resection, and chemo port insertion by experts in the field of oncology, which was not only broadcast to the audience at the venue but also across the country and the globe via various online streaming platforms such as Zoom & YouTube. The following two days were intense learning and upskilling by means of a packed scientific session consisting of various lectures, symposiums, video demonstrations, debates & panel discussions, & numerous paper-poster presentations & Quiz with attractive prizes, as well.

### Highlights of the Conference:

**Day 0 (Pre-Conference)-** Pr-Conference workshop was designed keeping in mind the interests of both young surgical oncologists and radiation oncologists, with live surgical workshop being conducted in Hall A, AIIMS auditorium and Brachytherapy workshop “Brachytherapy Practicum” in Hall B.

#### **Live surgical workshop (Hall A):**

The day started with a brief welcome & lamp lighting by the dignitaries, followed by excellent live surgical demonstrations:-

1. **Breast Conservation Surgery and Sentinel Lymph node biopsy by ICG Fluorescence by Dr. SVS Deo (Delhi).**
2. **Robotic Low Anterior Resection- by Dr. Surender Kumar Dabbas (Delhi).**
3. **Thyroidectomy with central neck dissection by Dr. Rajendra Toprani (Ahmedabad).**
4. **Chemo port insertion by Dr. Uttam Soni (Jaipur).**

The afternoon was all about master video demonstrations where young national faculty demonstrated various oncological procedures through pre-recorded videos of some common as well as some less done procedures like Pedicle Freezing in Liquid nitrogen: a technique for recycling tumor bone, Lap Whipples's operation, Uniportal VATS Ivor Lewis Esophagectomy, Robot-assisted left hemicolectomy, Round block Oncoplasty and Robotic Thymectomy, etc.

#### **Brachytherapy workshop (Hall B)**

The basics of brachytherapy were discussed with instruments demonstration & hands-on sessions for the same. The use of brachy in various cancers like oral, oesophageal, rectal, breast, and cervical cancers was discussed. There was a session on endobronchial brachytherapy & mold-brachy and its applications. Our experience of brachytherapy here at AIIMS Jodhpur was presented. & the day culminated in a lecture on a surgeon's perspective of brachytherapy.

The day culminated with an EC meeting followed by a Faculty Dinner with melodies of ghazal and fever of FIFA world cup screening live in the hotel.

**Day 1:** Day 1 of the conference began early at 8:00 am with award oral papers presentation in Hall A, followed by a master video session on tracheal resection and reconstruction, uniportal VATS lobectomy and lap Whipple's operation. Scientific sessions included keynote lectures by eminent national faculty and heated but very informative panel discussions on Head and Neck tumors, Breast cancer, Esophageal Cancer, Gastric Cancer, Hepatobiliary, and Pancreatic Cancer. Prof. Mark Fergusson from the University of Chicago delivered an online keynote lecture on two-field vs. three-field lymphadenectomy in esophageal cancer.

Various symposia also included talks on stapling devices, stoma care & their clinical outcomes, the future of robotic surgery, prognostication with biomarkers in early breast cancer, treatment benefits of Cyclin Inhibitors, and Immunotherapy in cancer. The day ended in a grand gala dinner at Bijolai Palace- a rustic outdoor fort resort in the vicinity of the city with folk music and dance.
